"Alcoholics Anonymous began with sponsorship. When Bill W., only a few months sober, was stricken with a powerful urge to drink, this thought came to him: 'You need another alcoholic to talk to. You need another alcoholic just as much as he needs you!'

"He found Dr. Bob, who had been trying desperately and unsuccessfully to stop drinking, and out of their common need A.A. was born. The word 'sponsor' was not used then; the Twelve Steps had not been written; but Bill carried the message to Dr. Bob, who in turn safeguarded his own sobriety by sponsoring countless other alcoholics.

"In A.A., sponsor and sponsored meet as equals, just as Bill and Dr. Bob did."

Step 10 ~ Continued to take personal inventory and when we were wrong promptly admitted it.

... Step Ten, which suggests we continue to take personal inventory and continue to set right any new mistakes as we go along.

Continue to watch for selfishness, dishonesty, resentment, and fear. When these crop up, we ask God at once to remove them. We discuss them with someone immediately and make amends quickly if we have harmed anyone. Then we resolutely turn our thoughts to someone we can help. Love and tolerance of others is our code.

It is easy to let up on the spiritual program of action and rest on our laurels. We are headed for trouble if we do, for alcohol is a subtle foe. We are not cured of alcoholism. What we really have is a daily reprieve contingent on the maintenance of our spiritual condition. Every day is a day we must carry the vision of God's will into all of our activities. "How can I best serve Thee – Thy will (not mine) be done."

We begin to see that all people, including ourselves, are to some extent emotionally ill as well as frequently wrong, and then we approach true tolerance and see what real love for our fellows actually means. It will become more evident as we go forward that it is pointless to become angry, or get hurt by people who, like us, are suffering from the pains of growing up.

Courtesy, kindness, justice, and love are the keynotes by which we may come into harmony with practically anybody.

Some tendencies to watch for:

1. When we have forgotten we are alcoholics.
2. When complacency lowers our guard and allows resentment and intolerance to creep back into our lives.
3. When we ease up on the practice of honesty, humility, and making amends.
4. When we become cocky over our AA success and cease contact with God.
5. When we lack interest in new members and feel it inconvenient to help them.
6. When we demand authority or expect praise for our sobriety.
7. When boredom makes an appearance.
8. When we start missing meetings.
9. When we stop studying the 'Big Book.'

When our inventories disclose any of these symptoms, we are in jeopardy of drinking. Our serious problem is self-centeredness. Further investigation will unearth a severe case of spiritual congestion.

Tradition 10 ~ Alcoholics Anonymous has no opinion on outside issues; hence the A.A. name ought never be drawn into public controversy.

We have seen millions die in political and economic wars often spurred by religious and racial difference. We live in the imminent possibility of a fresh holocaust to determine how men shall be governed, and how the products of nature and toil shall be divided among them. That is the spiritual climate in which AA was born, and by God's grace it has nevertheless flourished.

Let us reemphasize that this reluctance to fight one another or anybody else is not counted as some special virtue which makes us feel superior to other people. Nor does it mean that members of Alcoholics Anonymous, now restored to citizens of the world, are going to back away from individual responsibilities to act as they see the right, upon issues of our time. But when it comes to AA as a whole, that's quite a different matter. In this respect, we do not enter into public controversy, because we know that our Society will perish if it does. We conceive the survival and spread of Alcoholics Anonymous to be something of far greater importance than the weight we could collectively throw back of any other cause. Since recovery from alcoholism is life itself to us, it is imperative that we preserve in full strength our means of survival.

The Buffalo Theory as explained by Cliff Clavin, of Cheers. One afternoon at Cheers, Cliff Clavin was explaining the Buffalo Theory to his buddy Norm. Here's how it went: "Well, ya see, Norm, it's like this...A herd of buffalo can only move as fast as the slowest buffalo. And when the herd is hunted, it is the slowest and weakest ones at the back that are killed first. This natural selection is good for the herd as a whole, because the general speed and health of the whole group keeps improving by the regular killing of the weakest members. In much the same way, the human brain can only operate as fast as the slowest brain cells. Excessive intake of alcohol, as we know, kills brain cells. But naturally, it attacks the slowest and weakest brain cells first. In this way, regular consumption of beer eliminates the weaker brain cells, making the brain a faster and more efficient machine. That's why you always feel smarter after a few beers."

We Suffer To Get Well ~ There is no way to escape the terrible suffering of remorse and regret and shame and embarrassment which starts us on the road to getting well from our affliction.

We Surrender To Win ~ On the face of it, surrendering certainly does not seem like winning. But it is in AA. Only after we have come to the end of our rope, hit a stone wall in some aspect of our lives beyond which we can go no further; only when we have hit "bottom" in despair and surrender, can we accomplish sobriety which we could never accomplish before. We must, and we do, surrender in order to win.

We Die To Live ~ When we work at our Twelve Steps, the old life of guzzling and fuzzy thinking, and all that goes with it, gradually dies, and we acquire a different and better way of life. As our shortcomings are removed, one life of us dies, and another life of us lives. We in AA die to live.

We Give Away To Keep ~ That seems absurd and untrue. How can you keep anything if you give it away? But in order to keep whatever it is we get in AA, we must go about giving it away to others, for no fees or rewards of any kind. When we cannot afford to give away what we have received so freely in AA, we had better get ready for our next "drunk." It will happen every time. We've got to continue to give it away in order to keep it.

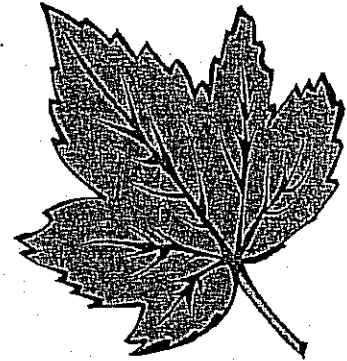

### COMMITTEE REPORTS:

**ENVELOPE SYSTEM:** Karen S. gave this report. \$235.00 has been donated as of September 15<sup>th</sup>. Year to date total is \$4118. Karen is rotating out of this position as of January 2004. Replacement is needed.

**STEERING COMMITTEE:** Charmaine D. gave this report. Present at Steering Committee were Representatives from Districts #1, #3, #6, #7 & #8. Also attending were the Chair, Co-Chair & Financial Chair of WNY Central Committee, as well as our Executive Secretary. Incorporating the Central Office was discussed. Chair of Central Committee to form an Ad-hoc Committee for Incorporation. Application for non-profit mail permit to be resubmitted. Change in answering service is saving money. The total cost for attendance at last month's Central Office seminar was \$799.87. The financial statements as of January 2004 will be moved two weeks later to coincide with the bank statements and simplify accounting.

**FINANCIAL REPORT:** Joanne McC. Gave the report. The contributions from groups over the past four months have declined, thus the fund balance has diminished. It is getting toward the end of the year so we hope groups will increase their contributions.

The Requirements for each position are as Follows:

**Section 1a. Co-CHAIRPERSON**

The Chairperson shall be elected by a simple majority vote of the Central Committee representatives present and voting at the meeting designated for the election of officers. Qualifications for Chairperson shall be that he or she be a member of Alcoholics Anonymous having a minimum of five (5) continuous years of sobriety immediately preceding the date of the election. The Co- Chairperson shall hold office for one (1) year. Upon conclusion of the Co-Chairperson's year in service, that officer shall move into the office of Chairperson in the month of January.

**Section 1b. RECORDING SECRETARY**

The Recording Secretary shall be elected by a simple majority vote of the Central Committee representatives present and voting at the meeting designated for the election of officers. Qualifications for Recording Secretary shall be that he or she be a member of Alcoholics Anonymous having a minimum of two (2) years of continuous sobriety immediately preceding the date of the election. The Recording Secretary shall hold office for one (1) year but may be eligible for re-election.

**Section 2 RECORDING SECRETARY**

1. It shall be the duty of the Recording Secretary to transmit to the Central Committee all resolutions or other communications pertaining to the business of the Central Committee.
2. The minutes of all meetings of the Central Committee shall be noted, transcribed and reported by the Recording Secretary.

**Section 1c. FINANCIAL CHAIRPERSON**

The Financial Chairperson shall be elected by a simple majority vote of the Central Committee representatives present and voting at the meeting designated for the election of officers. Qualifications for Financial Chairperson shall be that he or she be a member of Alcoholics Anonymous having a minimum of five (5) continuous years of sobriety immediately preceding the date of the election. The Financial Chairperson shall hold office for two (2) years and shall not be eligible for re-election as Financial Chairperson. The Financial Chairperson is an authorized co-signer of all checks issued on the bank accounts of the Central Office.

### **Section 3. FINANCIAL CHAIRPERSON**

The Financial Chairperson shall make a monthly review of the income and expenses of the Central Committee and report on same at the Central Committee meeting. Qualifications for this office are in Article III, Section 1c.

### **Section 1. STEERING COMMITTEE**

This committee shall be composed of eight (8) members. Each member shall represent a designated number of groups based upon geographic boundaries as drawn by the Chairperson of the Central Committee with the advice and consent of the Central Committee.

#### **Section 1a.**

Qualifications for membership shall be that he or she be a member of Alcoholics Anonymous having a minimum of three (3) continuous years of sobriety preceding the date of election. These members should be elected from their own districts.

#### **Section 1b.**

The term of office for each member shall be two (2) calendar years from the date of the member's election. Members can be re-elected at a later date. Nominations for membership on this committee are to be made at the Central Committee meetings held in the months of January, March, July and November. Elections are to be held at the Central Committee meetings in the months of February, April, August and December. Elected members are to assume office immediately. Whenever vacancies occur on the Committee for any reason, such unexpired term or terms shall be filled by a qualified member of AA named by the Steering Committee and subject to the approval of the Central Committee. Upon fulfillment of this unexpired term, the appointee shall be eligible for election to the Steering Committee.

#### **Section 2a.**

The Steering Committee's primary purpose is to oversee AA matters where the individual groups' action may affect either groups in the area or AA as a whole. It also follows through with any recommendations made by the Central Committee and make suggestions and recommendations to the Central Committee.
